SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Candidates for the Buffalo Public School District Scholarship should complete this application no later than February 15th and meet the following criteria:

- Gain admission as a freshman for the fall entry term of the academic year.
- Earn a G.P.A. of 90 (3.0/4.0) or better in a rigorous college preparatory high school curriculum consisting of at least three years of math and science, four years of English and history/social studies, and one year of a foreign language.
- Achieve a minimum combined math and critical reasoning score of 1200 on the SAT 1 or a minimum composite ACT score of 26.
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
