

### 2017-2018 Endowed and Restricted Scholarships

An eligible student must:

- Be enrolled for 12 credit hours as an undergraduate student or 9 credit hours as a graduate student, in a Bachelor's, Master's, Doctoral (Physical Therapy, Chiropractic, or Pharmacy) Programs.
- Have a 2.75 average at the end of the Fall 2016 semester at D'Youville College.
- U.S., Canadian and International students ARE eligible.
- Students enrolled in Certificate Programs, RN to BSN program and other doctoral programs are not eligible.
- Students who are at D'Youville College for the first time in spring 2017 are not eligible.

#### Application Procedure

1. All students must sign the Scholarship Application / Criteria page at the bottom of these instructions.
2. All students must compose an essay that is no more than **one-page (double-spaced)** describing the particular circumstances that demonstrate the student's need for the scholarship. Include your personal strengths, community service and leadership experiences.
3. **U.S. students** must complete the [2017-2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid \(FAFSA\)](#). The application should be transmitted before **April 1, 2017** to insure its receipt at the processor by **April 15, 2017**.
4. **Canadian and International students** must complete the Endowed and Restricted Scholarship Financial Questionnaire for Canadian & International Students (which can be found [online](#)). Their income must be converted to U.S. dollars using the online conversion chart. A signed copy of the 2015 tax return and the conversion rate from the Internet must be attached.
5. Submit all of the above to the Financial Aid Office, KAB 208, by **April 15, 2017**.

Students will be notified in early June of the results. The scholarships will be incorporated in the Financial Aid packages for the 2017-2018 academic year.
