Students are also responsible for any costs associated with drug screenings and/or background checks (which may be required by a clinical site).

**Students are responsible for all clinical travel expenses, including transportation, meals and lodging. These expenses are variable and will be likely to increase if a student chooses to do out-of-state rotations. The program may also require a student to complete distant in-state rotations at the student's expense, depending on site availability.
