New Student Contract

I understand that I have been accepted at D'Youville College as an HEOP student. As a full-time HEOP student, I will receive academic and financial support services. In order to receive and maintain these benefits, I agree to do the following:

1. Maintain satisfactory academic progress. The college catalog outlines the requirements to continue receiving federal and NYS financial aid assistance. I understand that if I become ineligible to receive any of my funding that I may also be ineligible to receive HEOP and NYC grants and may be removed from the HEOP roster.
2. Take required tests. This includes the placement tests administered by the HEOP office.
3. Register for non-credit remedial and credited courses during the academic year.
4. Attend all scheduled classes regularly. Grades of FX (resulting from non-attendance) are not acceptable.
5. Register for and utilize tutorial services. Tutoring is mandatory. Individual and group tutoring in academic coursework is available through the Learning Center. You should also request additional assistance from your course instructors, as needed.
6. Meet with your assigned HEOP counselor for weekly scheduled counseling appointments.
7. Participate in as many freshman workshops as possible, but no less than three per semester.
8. I authorize the NYC HEOP staff to discuss my academic progress with colleagues, and/or parents/guardians if in the professional opinion of a staff member such communication would enhance my academic performance.
9. I understand that my enrollment as an HEOP student will continue as long as I am entitled to, and remain eligible for payments under the New York State Tuition Assistance Program (TAP), the Federal Pell Grant Program, and HEOP and that ten (10) is the maximum number of semesters, at all schools combined, for which any student may be funded by HEOP. Accordingly, based on the information provided to date, it appears that I have _____ semesters of HEOP eligibility available for use.
10. I understand that my enrollment as an HEOP student may be rescinded if I receive any non-academic disciplinary action from the college (ex., drinking, use of drugs, violent behavior). Please refer to "College Policies" on page 117 of the Student Resource Guide and Planner.
