Center for Global Engagement TRANSFER – IN INFORMATION FOR F-1 STUDENTS

Congratulations on your application for admission to D'Youville College. We are happy that you want to continue your U.S. education with us. This information is provided to help you maintain your F-1 student status.

The Department of Homeland Security requires that F-1 students complete a “school transfer” when beginning studies at a new school.

WHAT YOU HAVE TO DO BEFORE YOU COME TO CAMPUS!

Notify your international student advisor at your current school of your intention to transfer to D'Youville College.

Schedule a “release date” with your current international student advisor for your F-1 record to be transferred to D'Youville College. Your D'Youville College Form I-20 cannot be issued until after this release date has been reached.

IMPORTANT: If you are completing (or have completed) your program of study or Optional Practical Training, you only have a 60-day period following this completion to have your F-1 record transferred to us. Your F-1 student status ends 60 days after you complete your program of study or OPT!

Complete the attached F-1 Transfer-In Information and submit it to this office as soon as possible.

Complete our International Student Financial forms and submit them with all required documentation to the DYC Admissions Office by mail.
